ABOUT ADVENTIST HEALTH SYSTEM

Adventist Health System is a connected network of care with nearly 50 hospital campuses and hundreds of care sites in almost a dozen states. It's Mid-America Region is comprised of providers in Wisconsin and Kansas, including Shawnee Mission Health. This Kansas City hospital network is made up of Shawnee Mission Medical Center, campuses in Lenexa and Overland Park, physician offices throughout Johnson and Wyandotte Counties and CorporateCare locations across the metro. On January 2, 2019, all of the system's wholly-owned locations will adopt the system name AdventHealth.

FAQ

What is a letter of intent (LOI)?

A legal document that states how we want to work together.

Is RMH being bought?

No. RMH will remain an independent county-owned hospital that is affiliated with Adventist Health System.

When will the affiliation start?

1st quarter of 2019

What does this mean for RMH employees?

Employees will remain employed and will be provided with competitive compensation and benefits and a secure platform for long term employee development.

Does the community sales tax stay local?

Yes. Sales tax proceeds will be used solely in Franklin County. The RMH Board will use sales tax proceeds solely for capital projects, funding of indigent care, and other similar projects supportive of RMH.

Why was AHS and SMH interested?

SMH has been working with RMH over the years and this takes our working relationship to the next level. We believe this will have a positive impact on patients and benefit the communities we serve. It is also an opportunity for AHS to share their mission of Extending the Healing Ministry of Christ and deliver on their brand promise of wholeness to RMH as well as provide greater access to the regional network of advanced medical care.

Will the name of the hospital change?

That will be studied during the due-diligence process.
